## A Summary of Educational Support for Non-Chinese Students 2023/24

School Name: Ju Ching Chui Secondary School (Kwai Chung)

Our school received the EDB special grant 2023/24 to support the Non-Chinese Students (NCS) in the academic year 2023/24. The teacher-in-charge/ task group was responsible to organise the related educational support. Details were as follows:

- (1) Regarding the progress and needs of the NCS, our school adopted the following measures to support their learning in Chinese during the year 2023/24.
  - ☑ Employed 3 additional teachers to support the NCS in learning Chinese.
  - ☑ Chinese Lessons:
    - Pull-out programmes (Level: S1-S6)
    - Co-teaching (Level: S1-S3)
  - ☑ Other Chinese Learning Support
    - Peers Reading Scheme (Level: S1-S5)
  - ☑ Others:
    - After school support :
      - (S1-S3) 20 students
        Employed a professional organization to provide some Chinese programmes for the NCS.
      - (S4-S5) 6 students
        Employed a professional organization to provide some Chinese programmes of GCSE examination skills for the NSC.
- (2) Our school adopted the following measures to enhance the Integrated Education :
  - ☑ Promote integrated cultural activities
    - The Chinese Department had some Chinese cultural elements in the school curriculum, such as Chinese idioms and historical stories, and simple literary works. Our non-Chinese students learned more about the Chinese history and culture. Some activities were organized by the Department regularly, such as Chinese calligraphy workshop, Chinese New Year Huichun writing, and cooking sweet dumpling. Moreover, our school organised the Chinese Culture Day, including lantern riddle guessing, paper-cutting art and other activities, which are good opportunities for non-Chinese students to understand and experience the Chinese culture.
  - ☑ Enable the non-Chinese students to learn and to share with the other Chinese students at school
    - The Chinese Department organised different activities, such as the author's talk, the literary walk, Duncan Ju Memorial Day, Chinese writing competitions, poetry and painting design competitions. Our school also provided various extracurricular activities such as Hong Kong Army Cadets and interest classes for all students to learn and to share with each other.

- (3) Promote home-school cooperation to parents of non-Chinese students
  - ☑ Interpretation/ translation of school policies/ school announcements/ school website and other information
  - Arrange non-Chinese speaking translators to provide instant interpretation services on Parents' Day; arrange teachers to meet with parents of non-Chinese students, explain their children's learning progress to parents, and encourage non-Chinese students to study hard.
